- There are 24 camp sites available, each with a 30 amp service.
- Sites are \$25/night and must be paid for in advance.
- Check in time is 2pm. Check out time is Noon.
- There shall be no dumping of grey or black water tanks.
- Pets must always be tethered or on a leash, and all waste must be properly disposed of.
- Fireworks are not permitted on range property.
- All open fires must be contained within the provided pit.

General Range Rules

1. Anyone on range property must be a member, purchase a day pass, be participating in an approved special event/group or be there as an approved hired service.
2. A membership is valid for the person listed, their spouse and their children under the age of 18, who are full-time students.
3. All non-venue hosted events and special groups must go through an approval process.
4. Anyone under the age of 18 must be supervised by an adult.
5. No one under the age of 8 can handle a firearm on range property.
6. Alcohol consumption is limited to the camping area.
 - a. Anyone under the influence of alcohol or drugs, including some prescriptions drugs may not handle firearms, nor be on any course or firing line.
7. Smoking and vaping are restricted to designated parking areas and private vehicles.
8. Absolutely no fireworks or explosive targets are permitted on range property.
9. Only service animals are permitted in buildings.
 - a. Dogs shall not run free and shall be tethered or on a leash.
 - b. Pet waste must be removed and properly disposed of by the pet's owner.
10. The Range Safety Officer has absolute authority on the range.
11. Report safety violations and unsafe conditions to any Venue Manager or Board Member.
12. Always follow Basic NRA Safety Rules.
 - a. Always keep the muzzle in a safe direction.
 - b. Always keep your finger off the trigger until you are ready to shoot.
 - c. Always keep the firearm unloaded until ready to use.
13. Always follow venue specific rules.
14. Be thoroughly knowledgeable of the operational and safety features of all your firearms.
15. Before firing your firearm, be sure it is in good working order and that the bore is free of obstructions.
16. Only use ammo recommended by the manufacturer of that firearm.
17. Be certain the ammo matches the caliber of the firearm.
18. Shotgun ammo may only have a shot size of 7 ½, 8, 8 ½, or 9.
19. Be cautious of reloaded ammo.
20. All firearms, except holstered handguns, must be unloaded unless on the firing line.
21. Unload all firearms; clear and open all actions during "Cease Fire".
22. Do not handle firearms during a "Cease Fire".
23. When on the firing line only have the caliber of ammo for the firearm which you are using.
24. Be aware of your actions and the actions of your fellow shooters.
25. Eye and ear protection is required when at or near a firing line where shooting is occurring.
26. Clean up your firing point, place targets in trash containers, and return target frames to the proper storage site.
27. All brass and hulls must be picked up by the shooter.
28. Archery is not permitted on range property.
